#### March 21 | MULTI-CULTURAL MONDAY

Wear clothing that represents your culture! Your culture can include one or more options like traditional clothing representing your family culture, sports jerseys, music culture, state/borough culture, colors of a flag, however you choose to represent YOU! Students will share out in class.

#### March 22 | BELOVED COMMUNITY TUESDAY

#### March 23 | **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT WEEK**

Teachers are provided with excerpts from the "Rebel Girls" series of inspiring women to read and discuss in the classroom. Students can write a short summary of the story that impacted them the most and discuss inspiring women in their lives. Staff and students can dress as their favorite current or historical inspiring woman. Examples of what students have done in the past are: dressing as a judge representing Ruth Bader Ginsburg, dressing in a lab coat representing Elizabeth Blackwell, the first woman granted an MD degree, wearing sports team shirts for women in soccer, basketball, tennis and more.

### March 24 | TOOM OF OP TOORSDAY

Classes will discuss and choose a theme that everyone can participate in to symbolize class unity. Be creative, choose colors, a themed print, common interest, or anything that unites and represents their class! Some examples from the past are:

Class pizza: red, white, and green to represent the ingredients.
